Dots to Useful Information? Help Enhance the "Map of OD"



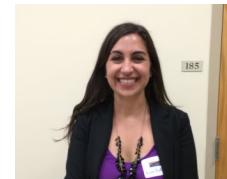
At June's Best Practice Session, Kent Linder presented a "map of OD" and asked participants to place sticky dots on the map

indicating in which OD "categories" they personally had experience and in which areas they were most interested in developing themselves/their practice. About 30 of the participants took him up on the invitation and at the end of the day a total of 229 dots were stuck on the map. In the 12 broad categories, the most dots indicating experience were on the sheets representing "Individual Skills, Knowledge and Perspective Training." In the development category, there was a tie between "Organization Design" and "Total Quality and Improvement."
